

AP Studio Art: 3-D Design

The purpose of this course is to assist students to develop a portfolio demonstrating a broad interpretation of three-dimensional space. This type of design involves purposeful decision-making about how to use the elements and principles of art in an integrative manner and will assist in refining their skills and results in the creation of artistic works to be submitted to the College Board for evaluation. Representation, abstraction and experimentation with a variety of drawing materials are explored. This course is intended to prepare students for the Advanced Placement Exam (Portfolio) in this subject and will follow the published College Board Guidelines. Prerequisites: Must have Art 1, with a combination or sequence of Art 11 and Art 111 – or Ceramics 1, Ceramics 11 and Ceramics 111 with a C or better. **Course Fees.** materials cost \$25.00; exam fee \$85.00. *College Credit for 2-D studio or 3-D design is determined by the universities to which the student is accepted.*
