

Applied Math

This Applied Math course is designed to be a bridge class between Algebra I and Algebra 2 with an emphasis on application. The standards are used in a contextual environment. The fundamental purpose of this course is to extend the mathematics that students learned in Algebra 1 in preparation for Algebra 2 in the future. This class is for students who have completed Algebra 1 and it has been recommended by their teacher. Some students who are currently in Geometry may benefit from Applied Math in which case there should be consultation between the student and the current math teacher. Anyone who has passed Algebra II or higher should NOT be placed in this class.
