This intermediate-level course explores the use of the computer as an electronic tool for drafting. It focuses on advanced drafting and problem solving techniques related to science, engineering technology, architecture, and associated technical fields. Students will use AutoCAD to produce detailed two and three dimensional computer generated drawings and gain an understanding of the role of computers in the drafting world. Students can earn Dual Credit (DRFT 109) from DACC with a grade of B or better in the course. Prerequisite: Technical Drafting, Intro to Engineering, or 10th grade. Cost to Student: \$25.00 per course
