

Chemistry in the Community

Chemistry in the Community is a Special Education only interdisciplinary chemistry course designed for students who desire an understanding of chemical concepts and applications but who do not plan to pursue science based careers. This lab-based course features activities that give students practice in applying their knowledge of chemistry. Seven units of study cover concepts explained in the context of societal issues, with an emphasis on organic, bio- environmental and industrial chemistry. Students learn concepts on a need-to-know basis, evaluate data, and make decisions based on their knowledge and observations.
