

Child Care/Work Experience

Transportation to field sites is the responsibility of the student. This course explores early childhood careers, education, and the skills, attitudes and knowledge needed to support families and their children from birth through 8 years of age. Students receive a certificate from the State of New Mexico Office of Child Development upon successful completion of this course with at least a "B" as the final grade. Students will work with children in community early childhood programs. The course curriculum may contain material related to human sexuality, reproduction and sexually transmitted diseases.

Prerequisite: Child Development. Class Fee \$25.00 covers CPR training.
