

Dual Credit Education

Dual Credit Education is a program that allows high school students to simultaneously earn college or vocational credit toward a postsecondary diploma, certificate, or degree at NMSU or DACC. The course is open to juniors and seniors who have a GPA of at least a 2.0. Students must pass the COMPASS assessment or have a score of at least a 15 on the ACT exam. Students must have a declared career pathway or program of study and have exhausted all classes in their career path at their high school. It is recommended that students participate in the EXCEL career exploration program before enrolling in concurrent education. **Prerequisite: Must be a junior or senior with a 2.0 grade point average (GPA) and a 15 or higher on ACT or a 114 or higher on the PSAT or pass the compass exam which is administered at Centennial each Fall and Spring**
