

Hospitality Internship

This course contains two components: curriculum and internship. The curriculum takes a deeper look into industry standards such as customer relations, accounting, management techniques, marketing, safety and security, beverage and banquet service, hotel operations, restaurant management, recreation, and event planning. The internship component places students at local hospitality businesses, where they will job shadow, participate in on-the-job training, and perform hands-on tasks. Students will be placed at off-site businesses to fulfill the internship requirements. Students must be able to provide their own transportation to and from their internship sites.

Prerequisites: Introduction to Hospitality, ProStart I, or ProStart II.
