This course examines the history and philosophy of law as part of U.S. society, and includes the study of both criminal and civil law. Topics include: history of laws and punishments, bill of rights and the Supreme Court, 9/11 and the patriot act, 2nd amendment and gun laws, 4th amendment and the war on drugs, murder, serial murder, racism and hate crimes, and forensics. Mock court trials will be conducted throughout the course within each unit.
