

Lodging Management I – Hotel Operations & Tourism

Students will discover the numerous career opportunities in the lodging industry at a variety of hotels including Suite, Resort, Bed & Breakfast, Casino, and Convention hotels. Students will become familiar with hotel divisions and departments and learn procedures for guest service, reservations, reception, and the night audit. Tourism topics include transportation, retail operations, attractions, the traveler, tourism development, and operational characteristics of a tourism business. The curriculum follows the American Hotel & Lodging Association (AHLA) Lodging Management Program (LMP). Students are eligible to receive an industry recognized AHLA LMP/HTMP Year 1 course certificate upon completion of the course and a passing score on the national exam.
