

New Mexico History and Health Education

*Please note: 9th Grade students must sign up for **both** New Mexico History and Health unless they have already taken the courses prior to registration.*

New Mexico History: This survey course supports students to become more knowledgeable and aware of the historical, cultural, economic, and political history of New Mexico and their geographical connections. Students will also analyze the role that New Mexico plays in national and international arenas.

Health Education: Course that provides knowledge and skills practice in a variety of health topics including the six CDC health risk behaviors, and must be aligned with the 9-12 PED Health Education content standards with benchmarks and performance standards. This course will meet the graduation requirement for Health Education.
