

Science of Wildlife and Forestry Management

Forestry topics covered are the processes of regeneration and reforestation, conservation of natural resources, erosion control, trail development and maintenance, mapping and surveying, operation of forestry tools, government regulations, and recreational uses. Wildlife topics include land and ecological systems that enable non-domesticated animals to thrive. Emphasis on how humans and animals may both take advantage of the same land, how to gain economic benefits from the land while not degrading its natural resources or depleting the plant and animal populations. **There is a \$10 fee for this course.**
