

UNM Computer Science

An engaging dual-credit computational science course open to all high school students. This course uses computer modeling to solving real-world problems. Computer programming exercises and activities will lead up to a final group computational science project in the students' areas of interest. Students will become familiar with the design-build-test development cycle common to computer science and engineering, and will learn computer science processes and tools while creating models of natural phenomena. Students who complete the course will be eligible to receive dual credit via UNM and NM Computer Science for All
